**Stewardship Campaign** – The income received from members to support our operating budget totaled 1.04 million dollars in 2017. Last year (2023) the income received from members for our operating budget was 1.00 million dollars (both numbers rounded). Inflation over those six years totaled 25%. GPC thus experienced a 29% reduction (25% due to inflation and 4% due to decreased giving) in our ability to fund key programs. Our future giving needs to increase *as fast as inflation* to avoid regularly reducing our programs and staffing. Please consider inflation as you pray on your 2025 estimate for giving to GPC.

Important Updates from the Buildings & Grounds Committee – The Installation of new windows was planned to start this past week (sometime between October 2-4). Blinds have been ordered and will be installed once they arrive. Scheduled improvements to the parking lots were delayed by rain. That work will continue as the weather permits. Make sure to allow extra time to find parking when coming to church activities. Many chairs in the sanctuary have become badly soiled. Please join us in the Sanctuary after the potluck today to swap them with clean chairs that we have in storage. Youth, we'll be happy to give service-learning hours for helping.
