Responsibilities will include bar set up, following recipes, upholding company specifications and standards, keeping the bar stocked and clean, and following closing procedures.

What You Need to Succeed

- Skills to Make the Grade – Multi-tasking, communication, attention to detail
- Job Qualifications – Must be of legal age to serve alcohol and have a minimum of 2 years bartending experience.
- Perform the Physical Demands – Lift and carry up to 30 pounds, remain on your feet for several hours, work under pressure, bend, reach, and stoop
- Experience in mixology and willingness to learn

An average day can range anywhere from 8 to 16 hours long (often ending late in the evening). This is a great opportunity to gain hands-on bar-tending experience and be part of an exceptional team.

As a key member of the team there are always last-minute schedule changes to manage, along with packing and unloading supplies, maintaining continued communication with team members, vendors and clients.

If you work well under pressure, are enthusiastic, strive to provide exceptional customer service skills and are ready to mix drinks in a fast paced environment, then this position is the perfect opportunity for you!

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Following Wildflowers set up and tear down procedures including inventory
- Setting up of temporary outdoor bars for special events
- Mixing signature cocktails, serving craft beer and wine both inside and outside
- Ensuring a well stocked bar is maintained throughout each event
- Educating customers on craft beer and cocktails
- Harvesting of herbs from the farm for cocktail garnishes
- Must be able to multitask
- Ensuring hygiene procedures are in place including routine sanitization
- Tear down includes the removal of tables/chairs/temporary outdoor bar at the end of shift

- 2 year minimum bartending experience
- Excellent problem-solving, organizational and time management skills.
- Detail-oriented, methodical and creative.
- You are organized, polished and professional
- Have unparalleled attention to detail
- Have exceptional client service skills and enjoy going above and beyond for clients
- Have a positive attitude and are very personable
- Handle stress with ease and remain calm under pressure
- Are willing to sweat and be on your feet for longer periods of time
- Are a team player
- Are keen to learn about botanical cocktails and craft beers

Must Haves

- Must have a minimum of 2-year related field experience in bartending
- Must have smart serve certification
- Must have reliable transportation
