

Laurel Avenue DAUGHTER'S BATH

The daughter's bathroom is a true highlight—one of the designer's favorites in the entire home. Pale pink quartzite covers the counters and the floating shower bench, immediately drawing the eye with its soft color and natural veining. This traditional vanity detail is balanced by pale pink antiqued Zellige tile that extends across the entire back wall and seamlessly into the shower, creating a cohesive, luminous backdrop. In striking contrast, a richly patterned Nero Marquina and Thassos mosaic defines the floor and continues into the zero-edge shower pan, grounding the room with depth and dimension. The mix of refined materials and unexpected textures brings layered visual interest, making the space feel elegant and distinctly memorable.
