THE EXPERIENCE

A simple, stress-free process
from the proposal to the grand exit.

If you love the final photos I deliver but don't love the experience behind them, I haven't done my job. When you look at your wedding photos, I hope you'll fondly remember the goofy faces I made to make your little nephew smile, or the hilarious pose I struck to get that perfect angle for a shot. I hope you remember how you felt in each moment and that you felt like you were present for your wedding and not just posing for the next shot. I prioritize communication, connection, and clear expectations throughout the process, so you'll know exactly what to expect each step of the way, freeing you up to focus on the most important moments of your big day and allowing me to step back and truly document your wedding day.

THE PROCESS

Let's break it down

Step 1: Coffee Chat or Video Call

After reading through this guide, the next step is to book a consultation with me (over video or in person) to discuss all of your hopes, plans & details of your wedding or elopement and create a package just for you.

Step 2: Make Things Official!

If we're a good fit and you'd like to move forward, I'll send you a proposal with a contract and invoice to make our partnership official. Once you submit it, your date is secured on my calendar and you can breathe a sigh of relief knowing you just found your dream wedding photographer!

Step 3: Get Prepped

During the weeks and months leading up to your weddings, I'll act as a personal guide, offering vendor recommendations, tips and tricks, and more. If you choose a collection with an engagement session, we'll schedule it for a few months before your wedding, and create a detailed timeline for your wedding day.

Step 4: Engagement Session

It's time to capture this special, fleeting season with beautiful photos! Your engagement session is a great opportunity to get comfortable with me and my camera and practice taking pictures together. Plus, you can use the photos for Save the Dates, wedding websites, and more!

Step 5: Say 'I Do'

Your wedding day has finally arrived. Whether you're in an Italian Countryside or on the beaches of the Gulf Coast, it's going to be great! I'll get to your venue about 15 minutes early to scout out the layout and lighting. You'll already know to have all of your details set aside for me so you can be getting ready with no interruptions from me- & your H&MUA will be so thankful! Thanks to all the planning and prep we've done, you can simply relax and enjoy the moment while I do my thing! Plus, if you need some help with the intricate buttons or stubborn clasps on jewelry you have a seasoned pro ready to offer a helping hand.

Step 6: Gallery Delivery

I'll send you a few sneak peek photos within a few days of your wedding to get you excited, then your full gallery will be delivered 6-8 weeks later. You can download and print them yourself, or I can create an heirloom-quality photo album for you. Pro tip: Plan a date night with your new spouse to look through the photos together and relive the joy of that day all over again!

DAY OF DETAILS

What to expect on your wedding day

The more thorough planning we do beforehand, the more you can go on 'autopilot' the day of your wedding and simply stay present! I've created a sample timeline below to help you visualize the flow of your wedding day as it pertains to photography. We'll chat about any unique needs/wishes you may have on your consult call, and then we'll go over your timeline together several weeks before your wedding to make sure we're on the same page and ready to go. These timelines are applied to both traditional weddings and elopements.



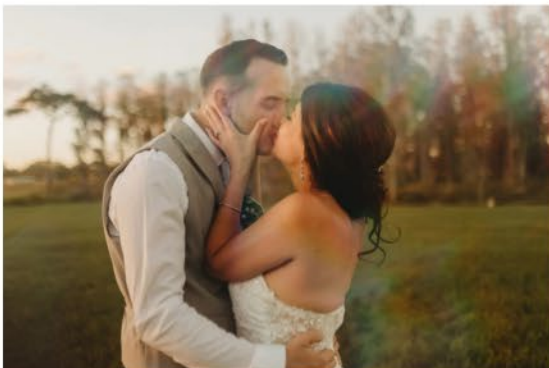
1:30-2:15 Bridal Details

3:00 First Look

3:15-3:45 Couple Portraits

3:45-4:20 Bridal Party Portraits

4:20-5:00 Bride in "Hiding"
