- Utilized transferable skills from accounting to manage photography business.
- Emphasized the importance of passion and excitement in overcoming fear and anxiety.

- Transitioned ARC from an interview website to a conference with live interviews and workshops.
- First ARC conference in 2016 attracted photographers from across Canada, the US, and even Australia.

25:00 - 32:00: Challenges and Growth

- Discussed the impact of COVID-19 on the photography and events industry.
- ARC conferences are returning in November.
- Emphasis on the importance of creativity, experimentation, and action in achieving success.

32:00 - 40:00: Architecting a Creative Life

- Introduced the Architect Lifestyle System course to help creatives design intentional lives.
- Discussed the importance of having a clear vision, strategy, and execution plan.
- Highlighted the need for continuous growth and reflection.

40:00 - 47:00: Work-Life Harmony

- Advocates for work-life harmony over balance, acknowledging the ebb and flow of different life priorities.
- Encourages regular reflection and planning to maintain alignment with personal and professional goals.

- Urges creatives to take action and stop overthinking.

- Stresses the importance of celebrating small wins and maintaining momentum.
