RECYCLING GUIDELINES




PAPER

Paper: Newspapers, magazines, office paper, junk mail, and other paper products. Shredded paper is NOT able to be accepted at this time.



CARDBOARD

Corrugated cardboard, cereal boxes, and other clean, dry cardboard materials. Please breakdown what you can. We cannot take used pizza boxes.





TIN & ALUMINUM CANS

Food and beverage cans, clean aluminum foil, and similar items. Please ensure all cans are rinsed prior to being set in comingle.





#1 #2 AND #5 PLASTIC

#1, #2, and #5 Plastics: Plastic bottles and containers labeled with the #1 (PET), #2 (HDPE), #5 (PP) recycling symbols.





GLASS RECYCLABLES

Glass is accepted in a separate container from your commingled recycling. Please place your glass items, such as bottles and jars, in a designated bin or bucket.



RECYCLING GUIDELINES




PLASTIC BUCKETS

Plastic buckets, pails, & storage containers that are labeled #2 or #5.



PLASTIC PLANT TRAYS

Clean and dirt free, plant pots, and trays. (HDPE or PP).



SMALL SCRAP METAL

Small Scrap Metal, must be less than 10 lbs and shorter than 18 inches (no sharp or tangled items).



TISSUE PAPER

Tissue Paper used for packaging, it must be clean and non-metallic, no glitter, or foil



PULP PACKAGING

Molded pulp packaging like egg cartons, and electronics packaging.
