

# Wedding or Private Hire?

Depending on the type of wedding you're organising, you may be questioning if you need a full day wedding hire. There are some key differences between wedding and private hire which are outlined below.

When can I have access to the venue for setup and the event itself?	8am till midnight (vacate by 1am) (bar open from 10am)	<b><u>Option 1:</u></b> 8am till midnight (vacate by 1am) full day hire only (bar open from 10am)  <b><u>Option 2:</u></b> 8am till 5pm (bar open from 10 am)  <b><u>Option 3:</u></b> 3pm till midnight (vacate by 1am) (bar open at 6pm)  <b><u>Option 4:</u></b> 12pm till 9pm (bar open throughout)
How far in advance can I book the date?	Whenever you want	We're unable to book a private hire event more than six months in advance.
