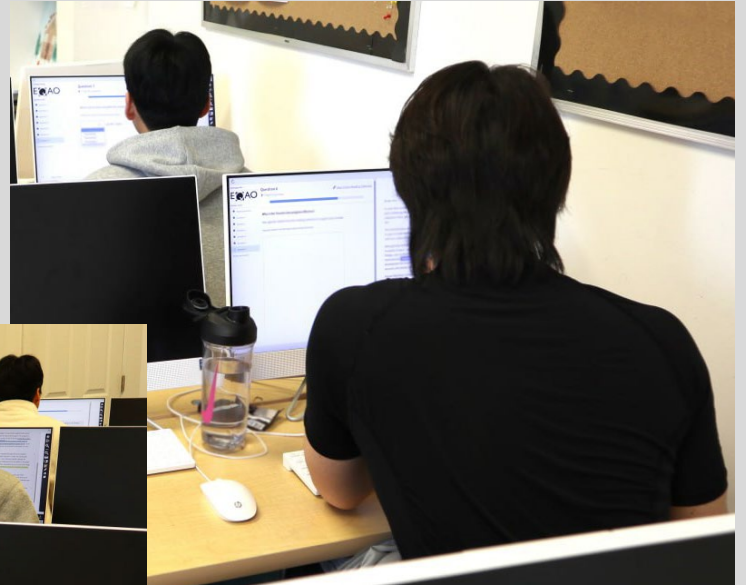
As the night ended, it was clear: TIA's graduation and prom night was an unforgettable success, marking a bright future for the Class of 2024.
