Interior & Exterior Lights

Turn on all lights, including floor lamps, undercabinet lighting, and other secondary light sources. Replace any burnt-out bulbs.

Personal Items

Store personal items, sports team memorabilia, religious symbols, and other non-decorative items out of sight.





Encure all coiling fanc are

Ensure all ceiling fans are turned off. A good rule of thumb is to move items like trash cans or other distractions out of sight and hidden initially to avoid relocating them throughout the shoot.



Remove all non-decorative items from counters, including soaps, cleaning supplies, and large appliances that take up counter space.



Clear refrigerator surfaces of magnets, notes, and artwork.

Arrange decorative items, like fresh flowers or a bowl of fresh fruit, if available.









- Open blinds or curtains fully to allow maximum natural light
- Arrange pillows and furniture to create a neat, inviting atmosphere.



Make all beds with clean, fresh linens.

Remove personal items from the room.

Arrange nightstands neatly with minimal decorative elements.

Arrange furniture and store loose items or hoses

Clean the pool and ensure all equipment is out of sight

Take down flags, decorations, and delivery signs.





Remove pet-related items, including food bowls, toys, crates, and beds.



No vehicles should be parked in the driveway or in front of the property

Ensure garage doors are closed.



Add subtle decorative touches, such as fresh flowers, vases, or candles, to enhance the aesthetic.
