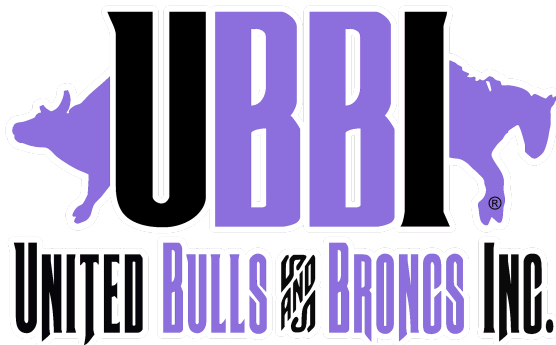
What is the new UBBI?

FOUNDING MEMBERSHIPS

- Limit 30
- Listed on UBBI Website and social media

- 1 VIP credential + 1 VIP companion credential Per show (must be the founding member with companion) and office must be told week prior to the event.

- Founding memberships that wish to sell a spot can sell their spot, but if you have a founding membership with shares. Shares do Not transfer with

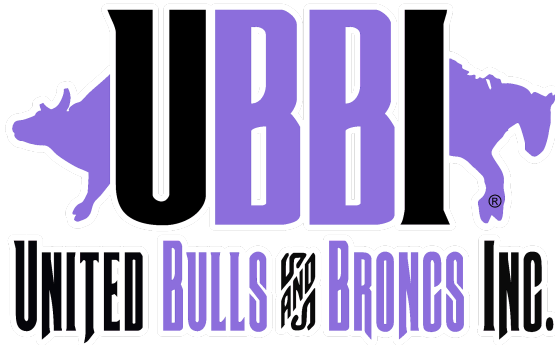
founding

membership shares revert back to the UBBI if founding membership is sold. Shares can only be purchased through the UBBI. This ensures Founding members with shares can vote on who can be a shareholder and vote on decisions and how the UBBI is operated.

- Opportunity for events to be held or sanctioned at member ranches creating an additional opportunity to share in the ticket revenue, event specific sponsorship revenues, and showcase their facility. (All events will be held to a higher standard and UBBI will be fully involved.)

GENERAL MEMBERSHIP/ LIFETIME

- All stock contractors and/or owners must pay a one-time membership fee each year. Lifetime membership is a one time payment with all general membership benefits. If multiple partners are paying entry fees, each partner will need a membership for the competing year. Will have access to shows, Prizes, and a finals with a two show minimum or if you do our nomination route.



Points/Finals

- The UBBI point system will be used to determine the Year End Champions of each class and side pot.
- Points will be awarded as follows:
 - 1st-5th place. Points will decrease by 1 based on placing until ending with 1 for last place.
 - Example 10 two-year-old horses entered. 1st 5 points, 2nd – 4 points, 3rd – 3 points on down to 5th (last place) receiving 1 point.
- The Year End Finals will be worth DOUBLE points and the year-end champion for each class will be crowned with Finals points included.
 - At over 200 Members mark we will go to 10 points

Payouts

All payouts will be as follows

UBBI will have an 80% pay back 20% Drag. Added money per class depending on the show and sponsors.

Side pots will be 90% payback 10% drag.

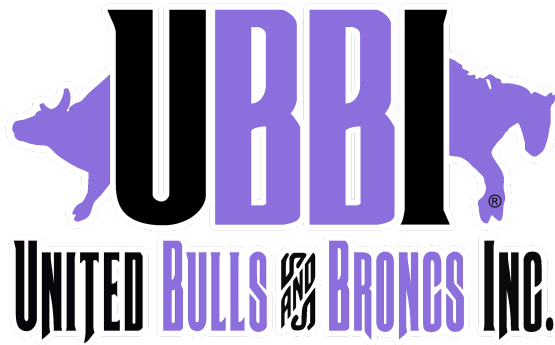
Rider pay out 90% pay back 10% drag for rider finals.

Pay out 1 hole every 6 Entries. Example (12 entries pay 2 holes, 10 entries pay 1 hole)

Checks will be cut at the end of every event or cash if possible!

Event Nominations You can nominate any event or association of your choosing nationwide. How it works 1. Must be a UBBI member. 2. Must nominate Four events of your choosing to be eligible for UBBI Finals. When nominating an event you must send the UBBI a \$50 per event per animal fee and picture proof where the animal was entered, animal name, animal number, and age. (Example draw sheet). This will not count towards year end points only to qualify you for finals.

JUDGING

THE SCORING – 4 judge system. high and low will be dropped.

Judges will look at criteria like:

1. **Kick**- Extension of back legs with each jump.
2. **Pattern** – Beginning and ending with a fluid motion, pattern, and proximity to the chutes.
3. **Timing/Rhythm** – Regular recurrent motion or natural flow. No tricks. No trash. Just a pure, honest, hard bucking animal.
4. **Intensity** – fire, energy, force.
5. **Overall** - How showy are they? Big jumps? Hang time? Wow factor? Flashy? Does he/she look RODEO? Showing all the abilities and strength.

Any animal shall be docked points for run off, walking on front end, flat spinner (no kick), and just flat being out of line but is up to judges discretion.

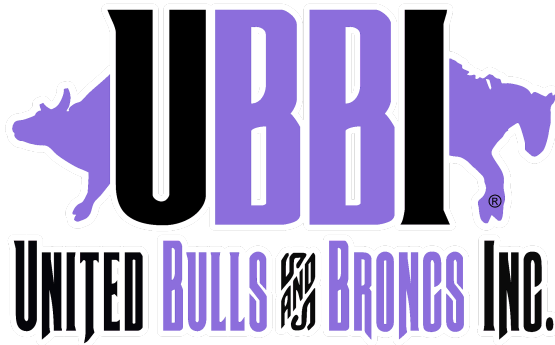
***You can challenge the judges decision but must have clear video proof from the judges view for review. And challenge before the next animal bucks. The cost is \$250. If the judge rules in your favor you don't have to pay. Money will be paid up front. In a review of any kind or challenge all four judges will be making the call together with a unanimous decision. In the case it is not the head UBBI CEO who will make the final call, to ensure fairness.**

Each Judge will have 25 (with .1 point used) points to give an animal, 5 for each category. Judge's sheets will be broken down to show how they came up with their score for your animal. All Scores shall be posted and available for Contractors to view as soon as possible.

***Judges will be two horse judges and two bull judges**

***If Judges are bothered during or before an event by anyone or a competitor or said competitors' friends/family/associates, it will be up to the Judges discretion if you are removed or disqualified.**

***Rider times to be added to the animal score of 1 point per second after four seconds. Example - Bull score is 80 points, rider rides for 8 total seconds bull score would be 84.**



JUDGING

**** Re-buck**

Rider Classes If your rider (that you chose) attempts your animal and makes it less than 2 seconds and you feel your animal was not shown to his/her best, you can pay a \$500 re-buck fee for another chance. Rider score on re-buck will not count towards rider competition. Ride time will. Animals will be reloaded at the earliest point the UBBI is able or will be in slack.

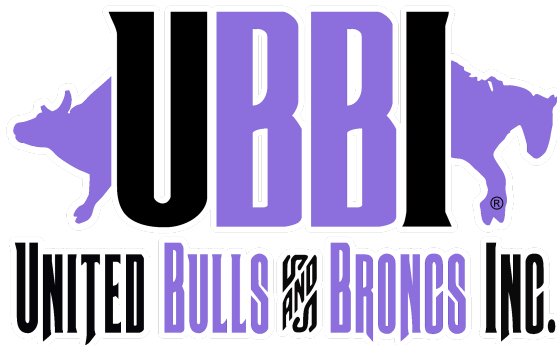
Example: A horse is awarded a re-buck and bulls have already been loaded, the re-buck will not take place until the slack of the event or after. Owners can choose to find a different rider or have the same rider get on for the re-buck.

Non-rider Classes – If you feel your animal was not shown to his/her best, you can pay a \$350 re-buck fee for another chance. Must request a rebuck before the next animal bucks. In a review of any kind or challenge all four judges will be making the call together with a unanimous decision. In the case it is not the head UBBI official will make the final call, to ensure fairness. Please see the judging page for challenge info.

Protest

Anyone wishing to protest an animal based on age, drugs, past performance, or ownership may do so. There will be \$500 cash required from the protester. If the protester is proven right, they will be returned the cash in full. If protest involves any testing of veterinary service the charges will be charged to the owner and forfeit any money won at the event if tested positive. And if positive will have a \$1500 fee to be paid from owner. If caught positive for a 2nd time you will be banned from all UBBI events. If the owner is proven innocent, All costs for vet and any fees will be given to the protester to pay. UBBI will make the final say along with a veterinarian if needed. And UBBI has all rights to test any animals at all events.



Falls

If an animal falls during the competition, (any part of the torso above the legs touching the ground constitutes a fall), the animal shall be marked zero.

3 and Out

If an animal fights the chute, after three attempts with a rider or to mount the dummy and is unsuccessful the animal will be put on a 3 minute clock then disqualified if unsuccessful. If your rider for your rider animal chooses to keep trying the animal after the 3 minute mark they will have 3 more minutes to get out if still unsuccessful the animal and rider will be disqualified.

Health- Welfare

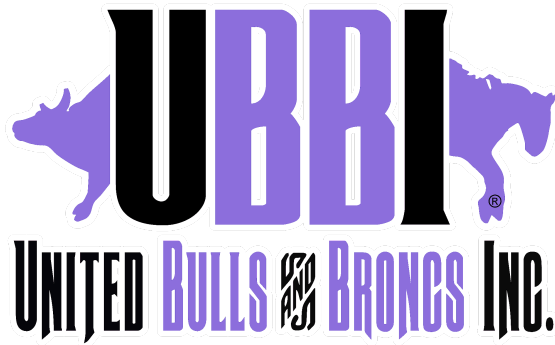
*UBBI officials or judges have the right to disqualify an animal if, in their opinion the health and welfare of the animal or event personnel is at risk.

Health Requirements

All animals must be healthy and fit for competition. All animals exhibited at a UBBI event shall meet the health requirements required by the state and/or locale of the event. If you bring sick or poor animals they will be reloaded immediately and you will be disqualified and fees will not be returned.

Brands

All Bovine must have a readable ear tag. All horses must be branded and readable. Any animal competing without a clear readable tag will be warned after the first event entry. At the second event, entry/competing will not be allowed. The identification numbers must be legible at all times. If they are blurred or haired-over, the numbers must be clipped or renumbered. UBBI must approve any exceptions to the above in writing. This is to ensure your animals are loaded correctly and backpen help can know your animal.



Check in will change depending on the event, keep up with the flyer or post.

Once CHECK IN time is over there will be NO EXCEPTIONS. Unless arrangements are made before the day of check in, trailers not in line to unload may result in forfeit of all entry fees paid.

Age verification – ABBI and BHBA registration will be accepted for age verification. Any horse not registered with BHBA or Bovine not registered with ABBI will need to provide a signed statement from their vet.

Age of Animal:

The age of the animal will be the year born in. Example for 2025 any animal competing born in 2023 will be considered a two-year-old all season, regardless of actual birthdate.

Horns:

Horns on ALL animals must be tipped to the industry standard:

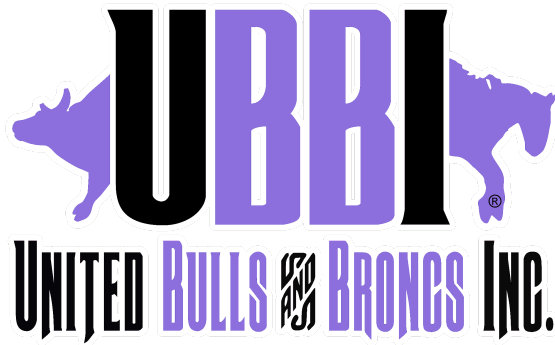
Yearlings and Futurity calves: QUARTER
Derby and Classic bulls: HALF DOLLAR

Animals unloaded that do not have horns tipped to the industry standard will result in a DQ and/or forfeit of entry fees. The owner/Contractor will have the opportunity to tip if able to at the show but the animal can NOT bleed.

Rider equipment: Bull ropes will be checked, bells are a must have. No foreign objects on your rope are allowed. Spurs will be checked (If they are sharp you better file them down). All Saddles and rigging will be checked and must have smooth soft underneath. No foreign objects (such as nails sticking out or broken equipment). This will ensure the safety for the animals, riders, and UBBI staff.

Dress Code:

During all Sales, Special Events, and night/show performance all contestants MUST adhere to wearing western attire (western hat, long sleeve collared shirt and pants) behind the bucking chutes and in the arena. This rule will be strictly enforced at ALL UBBI events. You will not be allowed near chutes, back pens, and the arena. And asked to leave. *During the days doing dummy classes no dress code required. But is asked to be in presentable attire.*

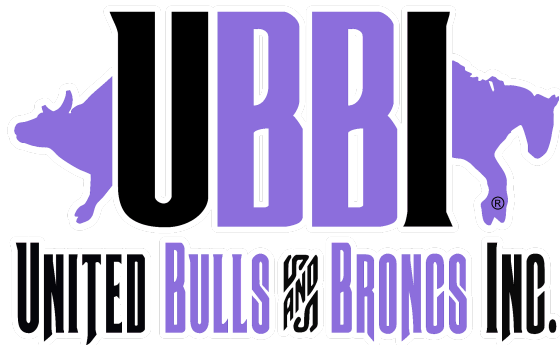


Animal Welfare:

No use of wire, zip ties or anything foreign the flank may be used. Standard electric prods may be used only when necessary, by production crew in the back and may only touch the animal on the hip, shoulder area, or nose. Any contractor/breeder or rider caught using unnecessary roughness or abusing an animal may be immediately disqualified from the event and charged a fine of \$1000. This holds true whether it is in the competitive arena or elsewhere on the grounds.

Banned Substances

The UBBI prohibits the use of anabolic steroids, drug masking agents, diuretics and specifically reserves the right to test, or to allow the event management to test, any horses or bulls at any time using accepted scientific methods in the industry. Testing expenses may result in a minimum lab fee of \$50 deducted per entry. Any entrant of a horse or bull testing positive for anabolic steroids, drug masking agents, diuretics may be subject to sanctions including forfeiture of any prize money and accumulated points, expulsion from the UBBI, a minimum fine amount of \$3500 and any other sanctions deemed appropriate at the discretion of the UBBI. Any animal testing negative but repeatedly showing high testosterone levels may be subject to additional testing at the discretion of the UBBI. The UBBI defines the following as prohibited “anabolic steroids”: Boldenone Undecylenate (Equipoise®); Stanozolol (Winstrol®); Clenbuterol (Clenbuterol Hydrochloride); Ventipulmin and any form of Testosterone. The UBBI may update the list at any time as deemed necessary. The UBBI will not allow the administration of any medications to a horse or bull prior to competition at a UBBI event without the direct supervision of a licensed veterinarian or head staff with vet reports. Violations of this rule shall result in a minimum fine of \$250.00 and disqualification of said animal at the event in question. Fines shall be levied by the UBBI. Failure to pay fines shall result in suspension of members. Medications may be administered after competition by the owner without veterinarian supervision, however a UBBI must be notified and be present during administration of medications. This includes any performance enhancing drug not listed or currently known to UBBI. All testing and sample collection will be performed by a licensed veterinarian approved by UBBI.



- **All Entries** – Entries must be turned in or called in 3 days before the event or will be charged a \$150 fine per animal. (example Bill Smith 2 yearlings, 2 futurity bulls and 1 3-year-old horse You can enter the Event any time before the first animal bucks or event has started but there will be a fine after the 3 days before mark per animal.) You will be able to enter online or call in.
- **Vet out** – any animal that must be removed from the event must have a vet note turned in no later than 24 hours before the event or you will not be refunded but you may substitute another animal.
- **No Show**-If you enter an event and no show (not approved by or spoken to head office) you will be charged a fine of what your entry fees would be the day you no show. And you will not be able to enter another event until fines are paid.
- **Rider fees \$150** - Must be turned in with animal entry fees, riders do not have to be named until you check in. If you need to change out your rider for any reason, do so with the event secretary at check in, if UBBI is not notified at least 1 hour before the event, there will be a \$100 fine assessed. Rider fees may change per event please see flyer for said event entering.
- **Non Member Fee \$100 Per Ranch/Owner per event**
- **Overnight pen fee** : Animals competing will not have a pen fee. If you have extra animals Must be approved by the head office 7 Days before the Event to have adequate pen space. \$100 Per pen Most likely 10X10. No more than 2 animals per pen.
- **Bad checks** - Fine \$100
- **Fines And Fees**- All fines and fees must be paid up before you are eligible to enter an event.
