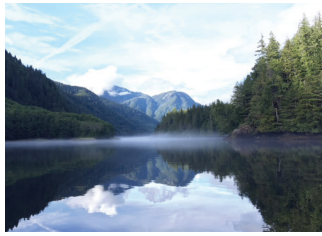
MEET YOUR GUIDES
