directions

- Gather supplies for moving boxes, tape, permanent markers, bubble wrap, etc.
- Assemble and pre-tape the bottom of your boxes.
- Use your Sharpie to number your boxes.

 Below each number write its room destination. EX: 1 Living Room, 2 Kitchen
- Write the box number on your tracker then detail the contents of the box next to the number.
- Close your box and tape shut! Move them to the side for your movers.

a few reminders about

MOVING OUT

As your excitement grows to move on to your next home don't forget about the person moving into your current abode. They want something clean and move-in ready the same way you do. Here's a few helpful reminders on what to do before you fully move on to your next home,



MOVE OUT RULE #1

Leave your house or apartment broom clean.

MOVE OUT RULE #2

Clean out the refigerator. If you are turning off the electricity before new people move in leave the doors to the fridge open so bacteria doesn't grow.



MOVE OUT RULE #3

Leave helpful information pamphlets for appliances, warranty info, HOA, etc.

MOVE OUT RULE #4

Leave your keys and all other home specific items - garage door openers, garage or keypad codes, shed keys, pool passes, etc.

THINGS TO DO

On top of the physical items that need to be moved you also have to adjust your servies for the house. This includes changing utilities and updating your address. Here are a few places and services you should make sure to adjust before moving.

CANCELLATIONS

As you prepare to move it's important that you cancel any address specific services. Some of these may be cancelled entirely while others may simply need to know a move date and address update so service can continue. Here are a few common items you should cancel before moving.

AT-HOME SERVICES

House keepers, lawn services, pest control, dog walkers - let them know you will either no longer need them or that you'll be moving your services to a new address.

CABLE + INTERNET

You may have a new service provider at your new residence. Be sure to cancel your current address so you aren't double billed.

UTILITIES

For most utilities you'll have to cancel service at one address and begin service at a new address. It is wise to set up new service for the day before your final walkthrough.

UPDATE ADDRESS

It can be hard to remember to do everything when you're preparing to move. Here are a few reminders of the places you may want to update your address before you head to your new home.

AUTOFILL

Update your computer and internet autofill settings so you don't accidentally ship something you order to your old address.

BILLS

Be sure to update your mailing address with your credit card company, student loan company, and banks

POST OFFICE

You can change your address online for \$1 through the USPS website.

SUBSCRIPTIONS

We tend to "set it and forget it." Make sure you update your monthly subscriptions - magazines, weekly meal boxes, etc. - so you keep getting your goodies!

UTILITIES

Not every county offers the same service providers. If you're switching counties you may have to select new service providers on top of switching the address of your current services. Here are a few of the most popular utilites and their contact.
