3-4 WEEKS BEFORE MOVE

- Begin packing non-essentials and labelling what's Inside
- Select & book moving company (if applicable)
- Cancel & finalize old TV, internet and utility services
- Contact new TV, internet and home utility providers to schedule installation.
- Plan daycare and pet care (if applicable)
- Update addresses for banking, CRA, Service Ontario (licenses, etc.)
- Arrange insurance for new home
- Arrange parking & service elevators (apartment).

- Refill prescriptions

- Keep important documents, keys and valuables with you.
- Do a final sweep of the old home to ensure nothing is left.
- Test appliances in new home (laundry, dishwasher, etc.) to ensure they work. (most residential agreements only give a short-period of time to mention and receive compensation for malfunctions)
