1. God's love <u>HOLDS</u> me when I feel <u>WORN</u> <u>OUT</u>.

CONSUMED – to do away with (destroy), to spend wastefully (squander), use up

2. God's mercy <u>RENEWS</u> me every <u>MORNING</u>.

"His compassions never fail. They are new every morning..." Lamentations 3:23

"Because of the tender mercy of our God, by which the rising sun will come to us from heaven to shine on those living in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the path of peace."

Luke 1:78–79

3. God's FAITHFULNESS invites me to SURRENDER.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS July 27, 2025

A PROMISE FOR EVERY MORNING

Before our eyes see anything, before we say anything, before we do anything, God has already spoken a promise over us.

CONNECT

What are your mornings typically like? Are they chaotic, peaceful, rushed, or reflective? How do those first moments shape your day?

ENGAGE

Which part of the message stood out most to you? Was there a verse, a phrase, or a story that hit home?

GROW

- 1. Read Lamentations 3:21–23. What stands out to you in this passage? What emotions or experiences might Jeremiah have been carrying when he wrote these words?
- 2. Verse 22 says, "Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed." What does the word consumed mean to you in this context? How have you experienced God's love sustaining you when you felt worn out?
- 3. Verse 23 speaks of God's mercies being "new every morning." Why do you think God designed mercy to be received daily rather than stored up?
- 4. Read Luke 1:78–79. How does Zechariah's prophecy about Jesus help us understand the kind of compassion God offers? How is this different from help that is distant or transactional?
- 5. Read Matthew 11:28–30. Jesus offers rest to the weary and burdened. How does His invitation to "come to Me" speak to you personally right now?

LEAD (YOURSELF)

God's faithfulness is not something you have to earn. It is what invites you to let go and trust Him again. Is there a burden or a part of your life that you are being invited to surrender? What is one step you can take this week to trust Him with that?or achievement?
