Rising from the desert landscape just north of Todos Santos, Nereidas is a brutalist statement piece softened by Baja's wild beauty. Concrete walls, clean lines, and expansive windows frame endless views of the ocean and desert, creating a space that feels both sculptural and deeply livable.

Inside, the home is minimal yet warm, with 3 bedrooms and 4 bathrooms designed for up to 6 guests. The open-plan living areas flow seamlessly outdoors, where a sleek pool and shaded terraces invite long afternoons under the Baja sun.

Balancing raw materials with thoughtful details, Nereidas is more than a vacation home — it's an architectural experience. A private escape where the desert meets the sea, and where solitude and style coexist effortlessly.

A 3,000-square-foot common area spread across two levels, featuring a 2,000-square-foot swimming pool, a sunken conversation pit, and a full bathroom with a shower. Just behind it, an open-air kitchen includes an imported, handmade grill from New Zealand. Furniture pieces by Oscar Hagerman, Fabien Cappello, and Don Shoemaker complement antiques sourced from markets in Tangier, Morocco.





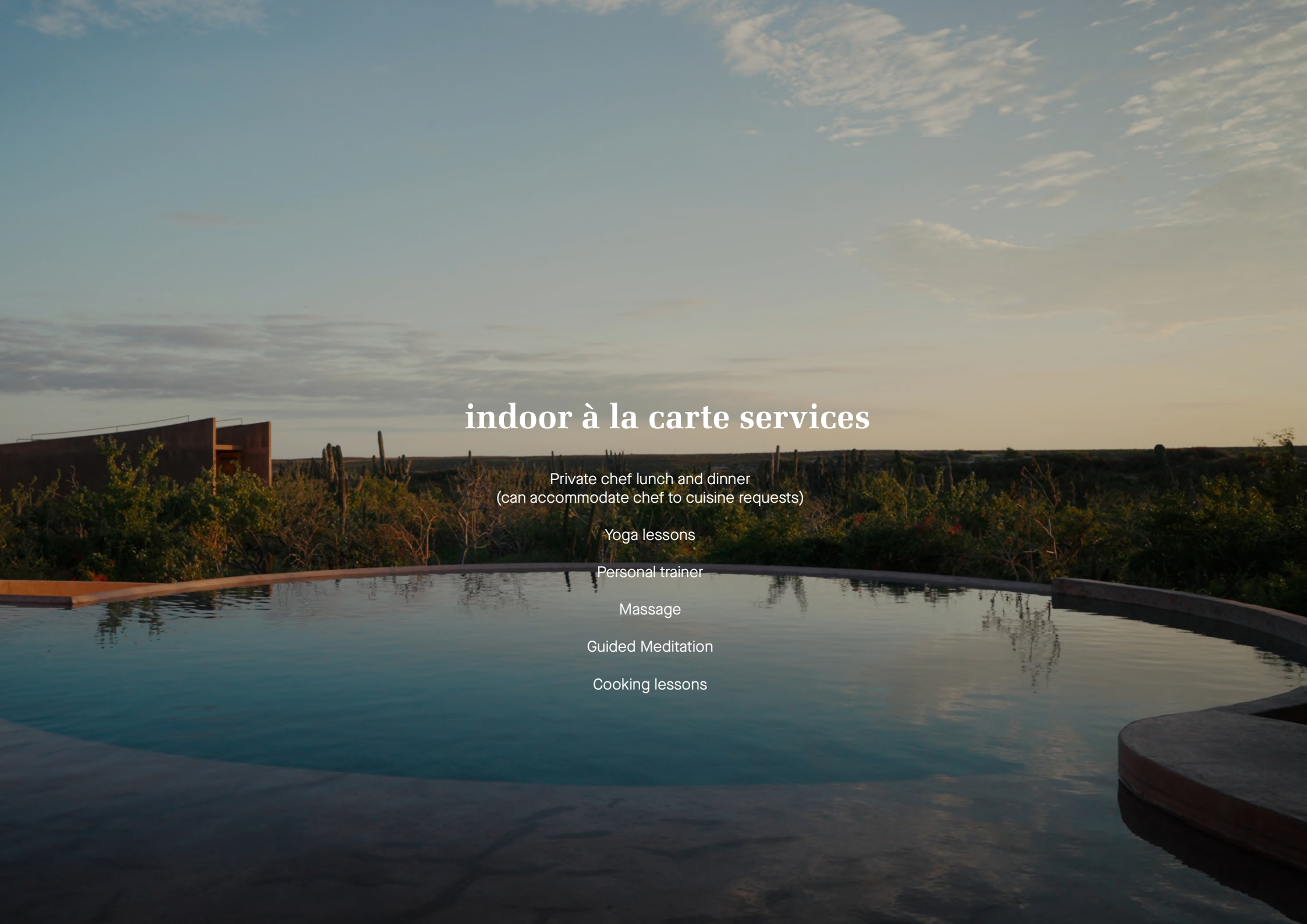

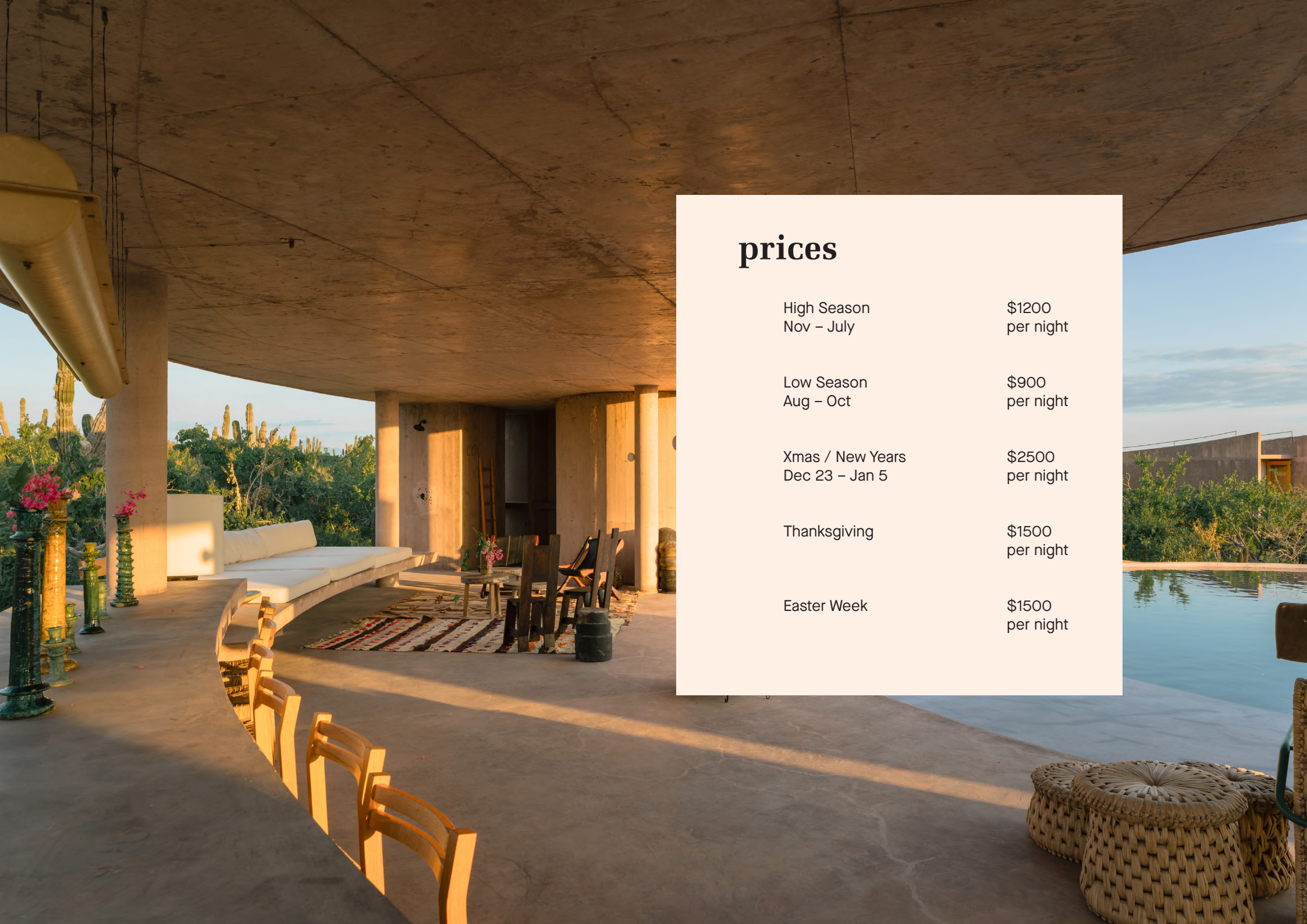
