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## THE VENUE WEBSITE ESSENTIAL ELEMENTS CHECKLIST

***Your venue website is NOT there to make the sale. It's there to get couples to book that site tour.***

Think of your website as Part One of your sales funnel. Everything else—those detailed policy documents, extensive FAQ sections, and comprehensive vendor lists—can wait until *after* they've fallen in love with your venue during the tour.

**This checklist focuses on the essential elements that actually convert website visitors into site tour bookings.** We've organized it based on what couples really need to see and experience online before they're ready to visit in person.

**Remember:** Keep it simple, make it mobile-friendly, and focus on getting that tour booked. That's your only goal right now.



## 1. CLEAR USER JOURNEYS

### **Distinct pathways for different clients:**

- Wedding couples
- Corporate events
- Social celebrations

### **Each pathway has its own:**

- Photo gallery
- Testimonials
- Pricing structure
- Calls to action

## 2. MOBILE-FIRST DESIGN

- All elements work on phones (80% of couples use mobile!)
- Touch-friendly buttons
- Click-to-call phone numbers
- Easy-to-complete forms
- Quick-loading images

## 3. STORY-DRIVEN DESIGN

- Brand colors that reflect your venue's personality
- Consistent design elements throughout
- Professional photos that tell your story
- Clear value proposition above the fold
- Design elements that reinforce your brand
- An About Us page that tells your venue story and introduces staff



## 4. PRICING TRANSPARENCY

- Clear base pricing or price ranges
- Well-defined packages/collections
- Organized into clear tiers

## 5. TOUR BOOKING SYSTEM

- Online calendar showing available times
- Mobile-friendly booking process
- Automated confirmation emails
- Brief pre-tour questionnaire
- Clear directions and parking info

## 6. CONTACT FORM ESSENTIALS

- Names
- Email
- Phone
- Preferred wedding date
- Estimated guest count
- How they heard about you - (keep this up to date!)
- Brief vision description

## 7. TRUST BUILDING ELEMENTS

- Recent testimonials
- Awards and certifications
- Badges from wedding websites (like Here Comes The Guide!)
- Professional organization memberships
- Preferred vendor lists
- Insurance/safety credentials



## 8. ANALYTICS SETUP

### Track these key metrics:

- Time spent on specific pages
- Most viewed gallery images
- Package page engagement
- Tour booking conversion rates
- Traffic sources
- Mobile vs. desktop usage
- Form completion rates
- Exit pages

## 9. CREATE A DEDICATED WEDDING INSTAGRAM

- Separate from main account (if necessary)
- Wedding-focused content
- Real wedding features
- Behind-the-scenes content
- Vendor highlights
- Detail shots that tell a story

## NEXT STEPS

- 3. Prioritize updates based on impact**
- 4. Test all elements on mobile**
- 5. Monitor analytics to see what's working**
