


Tip 5: Have an Evening Portrait Session

Whether it's a luxury hotel room or a designated spacious area at the wedding venue, creating a comfortable space for them can help set the tone for a fun and enjoyable day.




Tip 9: Avoid Long Speeches


Brucey Bonus Tip: Embrace Wet Weather on Your Wedding Day
