

Read 2 Corinthians 12 and discuss Paul's "thorn" he had to endure. What 'thorn' have you had to wrestle with in your life that you need to surrender to God?

[LEAD (YOURSELF)]

This week:

Give a name to your 'weight'? Addiction. Career. Kids. Marriage. Cancer. Depression. Bitterness. Unforgiveness. Family Conflict.

What is it in your life...you can admit is more than you can handle? Because it may be light for a while, or maybe it started out as light...but now – it's more than you can handle. It's more than you can handle because you weren't meant to carry it, or go through it... by yourself.

Stop relying on yourself...and start relying ONLY on God. Say, "God, I can't hold this on my own. It's too much. It's too heavy. It's more than I can handle. I need your presence. I need your process...and I need your power."
