- 2. Floats exceeding 15 ft. in height, measured from ground, may be disqualified.
- 3. Walking beside and touching the float detracts from its appearance and may affect the judges scoring.
- 4. Nothing may be thrown from floats/marching groups into the crowd. This is a City Ordinance violation, and violators will be cited/fined.
