

Respecting and protecting client privacy have always been vital to our relationships with clients.

The attached Privacy Notice, which is now in a format recommended by federal regulators, describes how Chilton Capital Management LLC and its affiliates (“Chilton”) keeps client information private and secure and uses it to serve you better. We take our responsibility to protect the privacy and confidentiality of your information, including personal information, very seriously. We maintain physical, electronic and procedural safeguards that comply with applicable legal standards to secure such information from unauthorized access and use, alteration and destruction. We hold our employees accountable for complying with relevant policies, procedures, rules and regulations concerning the privacy and confidentiality of information. At Chilton, we understand that our relationship with you is based on trust. This is reflected in everything we do, including the way we handle our clients' nonpublic personal information.

The types of personal information we may collect from you when establishing an account with Chilton include your name, date of birth, social security numbers, taxpayer identification numbers, driver's license numbers, bank account numbers, transaction history, email address, mailing address, telephone numbers and other personal information. In addition, from time to time, we gain access to your personal information through: (i) our interaction with you on the telephone, in person or through e-mail; (ii) account applications or other forms you complete; (iii) transactions in your accounts or on your behalf; (iv) investment advisory or financial planning tools or other information tools we may make available to you; and (v) third parties with whom we deal, such as consumer -reporting agencies, to verify information we receive from you and your credit worthiness.

It is Chilton's policy not to disclose any of your nonpublic personal information to third parties without your consent, unless those parties are providing services or support to us and have agreed to keep your nonpublic personal information confidential. Even if you cease to transact business with Chilton, we will continue to apply the same protections to your nonpublic personal information as we did when you were an active client.

FACTS WHAT DOES CHILTON CAPITAL MANAGEMENT LLC DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why? Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What? The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income
- other personal information
- account balances and transaction history
- credit history and payment history

How? All financial companies need to share customers’ personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers’ personal information; the reasons the Private Bank chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Who is providing this notice?	Chilton Capital Management, LLC (“Chilton”)

What we do	
How does Chilton protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. We authorize our employees, agents and contractors to get your information only when needed to do their work for us. We require companies working for us to protect your information.
How does Chilton collect my personal information?	We collect your personal information, for example, when you: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ open an account or seek advice about your investments ▪ direct us to buy securities or sell securities We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	Federal law gives you the right to limit only: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes – information about your creditworthiness ▪ affiliates from using your information to market to you ▪ sharing for non-affiliates to market to you State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Our affiliate includes Chilton Capital Management Trust Co.</i>
Non-affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ <i>Chilton and its affiliates does not share with non-affiliates so that they can market to you.</i>
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Chilton doesn't jointly market.

Other important information
State Laws: CA: Accounts with a California address are automatically treated as if they have limited the sharing and we will not share information about you within, or with financial companies outside, our family of companies unless we first provide you with privacy choices or unless otherwise permitted by law.
