QUESTIONS TO ASK YOUR SURGEON

What is the surgery called?
Why do I need it?
What are the benefits and success rate of this surgery?
Are there alternatives, e.g., a different type of surgery, non-surgical options?
Should I get a second opinion?
What are the side effects, risks and potential complications?
Are there any other downsides to this type of surgery?
What will happen if I delay or don't have the operation?
Who will perform the operation and how many times have they done this surgery?
How many hours will the operation take?
How is the surgery done, e.g., laparoscopy, open incision?
What type of anesthesia will be used, e.g. local, regional, general?
What will I need to do before the operation, e.g., lab tests. fasting, medication changes?
Are there things I can do before the operation to help with surgery and healing?
How painful is it healing from this type of surgery?
How long is the hospital stay?
What can I expect during the recovery phase?
How long will I need to be off work?
What kind of help will I need at home, if any?
What medications will I need to take afterward? Can I get the prescriptions pre-filled now?
Will I need any special therapy/rehab after the operation, e.g., physio?
Will I need any special equipment after, e.g., crutches, walker, brace?
How will the operation impact daily activities, e.g., driving, bathing, exercising, household chores, sexual activity?
How long will it be until I'm fully recovered and back to normal?
How much will it cost?
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
