

Prompt Clue Hunt

Setup: Laminate the cards for durability and hide them around the classroom or schoolyard. Each question card should have a matching answer card hidden in a separate location.

Goal: Teams receive a plain sheet of paper to track their progress. They must find a question card, write the question on their sheet, and then search for the matching answer card to complete the pair. Teams must successfully find and match all the questions and answers. All cards remain in hiding spots to allow all groups to participate. Younger students can be paired with older ones for writing if desired or students can use the enclosed booklet (make enough copies for the amount of questions used).

Why is it important to show gratitude to the land?

To respect and give back for what we take from nature.

What can rose hips be used for?

Making jelly or tea.

What does reciprocity mean in Métis culture?

Giving back to the land what we have taken.

How can you identify a stinging nettle?

By its serrated leaves and tiny hairs that sting when touched.

How can we protect native plants in our community?

By not over harvesting and planting more.

Why are plants important to Métis culture?

They are used for food, medicine, and tools.

Which traditional Métis plant is known for its vitamin C content?

Rose hips.

Which plant's root was traditionally used to soothe sore throats?

Marshmallow root.

What is pine pitch commonly used for besides sealing buckets?

As a natural adhesive or glue.

What is spruce gum traditionally used for?

As a natural chewing gum and antiseptic.

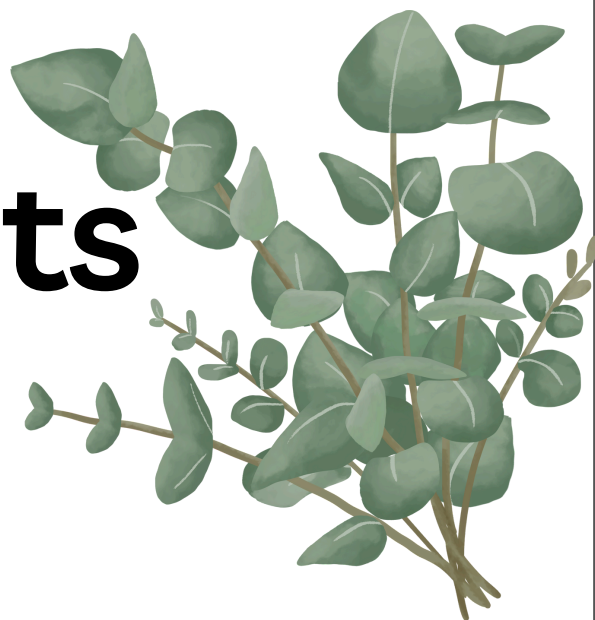




