Camps: Triple R Ranch offers more than one type of camp experience! See the front of the registration form for dates and prices.

<u>Adventure Camp:</u>	Camp is Sunday through Friday. Check-in is Sunday at 5:00pm and check-out is Friday at 5:00pm each week. Campers rotate through Morning Skill Area activities each morning with their cabin mates through a different schedule of skill areas each day (see Morning Skill Areas below). Afternoons are spent at the pool, playing games, more skills at optional electives (additional fees - see front of registration form), or hanging out with friends at the camp store, the "Trading Post." In the evening, all campers enjoy Bible discovery hour and camp-wide programs that round out the day.
<u>Mini Camp</u> :	Camp is Sunday through Wednesday. Check-in is Sunday at 5:00pm and check-out is Wednesday at 5:00pm. Campers enjoy a shortened version of Adventure Camp. Horsemanship Electives: Ages 8-14. For adventure, Teen, and Day camp ONLY. Additional Fees apply (see front of form)

Horsemanship Track (ages 8+)- This is for campers who want to spend more time with horses and go further in their horse handling skills. Two hours each morning of the week is spent at the stables learning to ride and take care of horses.

Private Riding Lesson- A one-on-one horseback riding lesson tailored to the individual's needs.

Additional Trail Ride (age 8+) – A horseback trail ride in addition to the one camper's are already scheduled for with their cabin.

Trading Post, the Camp Store

The Trading Post is the camp store where campers get an opportunity each day to purchase snacks and souvenirs. Many snack options are available like chips, cookies, crackers, ice cream, water, soda, juice, etc. Souvenirs available vary from year-to-year but always include t-shirts, bandanas, bumper stickers, reusable water bottles, and other items to remind campers of their time at camp.

Parents pre-pay an amount for each camper's account before the week arrives. Campers will only be able to make purchases on their account and not with physical money; it is against camp rules for campers to bring money with them to camp. If they do, it will be turned into the office and can be picked up at the end of the week. If you would like to add Trading Post funds at the time of registration, simply add the amount to your total payment.

Online, parents can go to the virtual Trading Post and purchase Care Packages, an exclusive yearly edition camp t-shirt, and other items to enhance the camp experience. Not everything available in the store is available in the online store.

Financial Policy:

A deposit of \$200.00 per week is required to reserve your camper's space. The deposit, of which \$100 is non-refundable and \$200 is non-refundable within 30 days of camp session, is applied to the total camp fee. The balance of all camp fees is due 7 days prior to your camp date. There is a \$20 session change fee (Waived until May 1, 2024). Triple R Ranch is a non-profit organization. We offer payment by credit card; however, payment with check or cash is appreciated. If for any reason you must cancel, a written notice must be submitted to our office. Notice for session changes or cancellations may be sent via fax to (757) 421-4178, or by email to camp@triplerranch.org. No refunds are offered in the event of homesickness or dismissal for errant behavior.
