Process

After that it's planning, session, and order appointment which will be explained in more detail at your consultation.

SF - Session Fee. Non refundable within 1 month of session

PC - Print credit. Must be paid at booking, refundable should you decide to cancel.

30 minutes

Either in studio or outdoor at RJP. Location fee of \$50 for off-site. Great for small families and kids!

\$250 to book
(\$150 SF / \$100 PC)

1 hour

Any location in Waupaca or Portage County. Great for large families or a small family with multiple wardrobes.

\$550 to book
(\$250 SF / \$300 PC)

1+1/2 hour

Typically one or two locations.

The right session for most seniors.

\$900 to book
(\$400 SF / \$500 PC)

2+1/2 hour

As many locations as we have time for. Right for the senior with lots of hobbies!

\$1200 to book
(\$500 SF / \$700 PC)

Update Sessions

You can do as many as you'd like within 1 year of first session.

Great for fall or winter sports, off season shots, or
