WHY IT'S AWESOME:

It's a riverfront park w/ a skyline view of Downtown Nashville!

Plan to spend your day here or use the park as your starting point into Nashville's downtown district. The park offers free parking, beautiful views, a splash pad, kayak launch and more! The pedestrian bridge takes you over the Cumberland River into Downtown Nashville and if you time it right, you can hear the music from Ascend Amphitheater!

Fun fact: The bridge was closed to automobile traffic in 1998 and has been restored for pedestrian use.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

Be prepared to walk and plan to spend as little or as much time exploring Nashville as you'd like.



KNOW BEFORE YOU GO:

This space is not ideal for game days or when there are events happening at Nissan Stadium.

WHAT TO BRING:

Dress for the weather! No trip to Music City is complete without your camera and a water bottle!

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WRECK OF PETER IREDALE

📍 Peter Iredale Rd., Hammond, Oregon

WHY IT'S AWESOME:

It's an old shipwreck (cir. 1906) on the beach!

Sailing from Salina Cruz, Mexico, the Peter Iredale was bound for Portland Oregon with 1,000 tons of ballast and a crew of 27, including two stowaways. The ship was grounded one foggy evening when heavy winds pushed it onto the shore. A lifeboat was dispatched and luckily there were no casualties but the skeleton of the ship remains to this day!

WHAT TO EXPECT:

Easy drive into the parking lot, quick walk down a sand dune to the beach, lots of photo ops!



KNOW BEFORE YOU GO:

Schedule your stop here around low tide! Tide charts change daily. Spend the day or make it a quick stop!

WHAT TO BRING:

Beach gear! A camera, a water bottle and a light jacket for a breezy walk. Spending the day? Pack a picnic!

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THE CANOPY @ THE BIRCHWOOD

WHY IT'S AWESOME:

It's an elevated rooftop bar with a view of St. Petersburg's waterfront parks!

Date night? GNO? Perched on top of the fantastic hotel The Birchwood, the roof terrace combines the Florida casual lifestyle with a higher-class lounge, furnished with cabanas, lounge sofas and fire pits.

Fun fact: The rooftop offers stunning views over Tampa Bay, Straub Park, Beach Drive and the downtown St. Pete skyline.

10/10 would recommend going for golden hour!

WHAT TO EXPECT:

This rooftop bar serves a fully stocked bar menu along with some tasty and seasonal bar bites.



KNOW BEFORE YOU GO:

Valet and metered street parking are available! Head up the ramp to left side of The Birchwood. Take the elevator located in the back up to the 3rd floor!

WHAT TO BRING:

Your ID! This establishment is 21+! We highly recommend business casual attire and comfy shoes!



NEARBY: Walk along the beachfront parks, dine along Beach Ave. and visit the St. Pete Pier!

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
