- 1 cup Borax
- 1 cup Baking Soda
- 1 cup Washing Soda (soda ash)
- 1 cup Salt
- 10-15 drops of Essential Oil (such as lemon, tea tree, or lavender for their stain-fighting and antibacterial properties)

Instructions:

1. Mix Dry Ingredients: In a large mixing bowl, combine the borax, baking soda, washing soda, and salt. Stir well to ensure all the ingredients are evenly mixed.

2. Add Essential Oil: Add the essential oil to the dry mixture. The oil will help give your stain remover a pleasant scent and additional cleaning power. Mix thoroughly to distribute the oil evenly throughout the powder.

3. Store: Transfer the mixture into an airtight container for storage. A glass jar or a plastic container with a tight-fitting lid works well.

How to Use:

1. For Tough Stains: Before washing, sprinkle some of the stain remover directly onto the stain. Let it sit for about 15-30 minutes.

2. Wash: Add 1-2 tablespoons of the stain remover to your laundry load along with your regular detergent.

3. Rinse and Check: After washing, check if the stain is gone before drying. If necessary, repeat the process.

Tips:

- Always test the stain remover on a small, inconspicuous area of the fabric first to ensure it won't cause discoloration.

- For particularly stubborn stains, you might want to make a paste with water and the stain remover and apply it directly to the stain before washing.

This homemade stain remover is effective and safe for many fabrics and surfaces, making it a great choice for busy parents!
